Dr.Cesar Valentin Castillo, was born in the city of Castillo, province of Duarte, Dominican Republic, graduated as a Doctor of Medicine from the Pontifical Catholic University, mother and teacher, Santiago, Rep Dom, married to Mrs. Fanny Torres, he is the father of three children. Cesar Valentin, Jr, Cesar José Valentín Liriano and Clara Maria Valentin Liriano, are his parents Ramón Valentín Santos and Francisca Castillo Méndez and he is the youngest of 14 siblings.

He attended his first studies at the primary school of "Yaiba pueblo nuevo castillo" and his secondary studies at the Osvaldo García de la Concha high school, in Castillo, Dominican Republic.

Dr.César Valentin, has been working in the pediatric clinics "Passaic Pediatrics", as head of the staff, for 15 years, in 3 different offices, located in Passaic, and in the city of Perth Amboy, New Jersey, from this position , Dr.Valentín, has contributed to the vocational development of the new immigrants who have ventured into the health area, offering them guidance, observational internships, to gain experience, and finally offering them jobs, throughout these 15 years dozens of them have obtained different administrative and academic positions, within their careers, which have allowed them to work in different recognized institutions.

Dr.Valentin is the owner of "New Jersey supplies" and also of "CVC messenger", companies which offer automated services 24 hours a day, processing phone calls, medical appointments, customer service, and channeling emergency calls medical offices, in different medical offices, from which it has contributed to offer dozens of jobs to members of our community.

For several years, through the Passaic Pediatric Clinic, Dr.Valentín has coordinated the annual humanitarian day in the Dominican Republic, which offers specialized pediatric consultations, and also offers donations of school supplies to children in low-income communities. , in different cities of the Dominican Republic.

His community work has been recognized by several organizations in the Dominican Republic, and in New Jersey. Dr.Valentín is an active member of various professional and community organizations.

Dr.Gustavo Pérez, married father of 2 daughters, graduated with a bachelor's degree in business administration.

He graduated as a doctor, in medicine, from the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo UASD, Dominican Republic, trained in radiology through the Central University of Venezuela, has a master's degree in clinical counseling through the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo, UASD, has a license professional in education from the State of New York, also holds certification from the State of Pennsylvania in Chemical Dependency National Certification. He resides in Philadelphia for more than 28

years, working in different mental health clinics, occupying different positions, until he is currently the executive director of the Harmony Wellness Group mental health clinic.

He is co-founder of the Dominican medical college, Valley Delaware-Philadelphia branch, the first and only association of Dominican professionals, in the state of Pennsylvania, specifically Philadelphia, co-founder of the cooperative of Dominican doctors. For 22 years, he has been an advisor to these institutions in several commissions, both in Philadelphia, New York New Jersey, and the Dominican Republic, representing these institutions always advocating for services to our immigrant health professionals, he was co-founder of the master's program in clinical counseling, through the autonomous university of Santo Domingo, which has graduated hundreds of professionals in this area.

Dr. Pérez has held political positions within the Dominican revolutionary party, then became the founder of the modern revolutionary party, representing the health sector within this party, coordinating an official visit by the former president of the Dominican Republic, Ing. Hipolito Mejía.

Gustavo Perez is currently president of the Dominican Medical Association, Valley Delaware-Philadelphia affiliate, and is also president of the organizing committee for the 20th anniversary celebration of its annual international medical congress of this institution, which represents medical professionals from the state of Pennsylvania, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

His work has been recognized by several institutions both in the United States and also in the Dominican Republic.

Dr. Perez is the staff manager at the mental health clinic, Harmony wellness Group, with 2 offices, located in the city of Philadelphia, which assists more than 7000 clients in the area of mental health.

In his 28 years of practice as a mental health therapist, Dr. Pérez has cared for hundreds of children, adolescents, adults and the entire family, helping them over time to overcome the challenges for life which represents the stigma of mental health, in our community.

Shaira Arias is an Emmy Award winning multimedia journalist for NBC 10 and Telemundo62. She can be seen weeknights on Noticiero Telemundo 62 at 6pm and 11 p.m.

Dr. Dante Sanchez, is a professor in the master's degree in Clinical Psychology at the Pedro Henriquez Ureña University, co-founder of the Dominican Medical College of the Delaware Valley, with more than 300 members residing in the state of Pennsylvania and New Jersey, Dr. Sanchez He is a writer, painter, folklorist, has contributed to the development of Dominican arts and identity in the city of Philadelphia, through well-established institutions such as the Dominican House of Culture of Philadelphia, and the Dominican parade and festival of Philadelphia of which he has been its president.

Dante Sanchez, was director, COMHAR/Latino Treatment Program. Philadelphia, Pa. the largest and oldest agency offering mental health services in the city of Philadelphia, Served over 3,000 Hispanics each year for 13 years. He helped get work visas for Dominicans.-Consultant-Citywide Comm. Counts. Services, where he trained Dominicans.-Official Executive Director.He was founder and director of Cognitive Behavioral Services Inc. Philadelphia Pa. From 2006, until the time of his death in 2020, With more than 50 professionals employed. and served around three thousand Hispanics per year for 10 years.

DANTE SANCHEZ ARTISTIC PROFILE

Dante as a writer, author of the book "The two caresses of pain" Poems, with the introduction of the famous writer and teacher Narciso Gonzalez (Narcisazo).-as Painter. Pictorial exhibition at the Juan Pablo Duarte School in Manhattan, NY; Joint exhibition at SKETCH, the first time that Hispanics exhibited in that traditionally exclusive place. -Exhibition at Taller Puertorriqueño in Philadelphia, PA.- Joint exhibition at the Philadelphia Board of Education-and at Hispanic Community Counseling Services, also in the city of Philadelphia.
