Yudelka Tapia is serving her first term in the New York State Assembly representing the 86th Assembly District, which consists of the neighborhoods of University Heights, Morris Heights, Mount Eden, Kingsbridge, Tremont and Fordham in the Bronx.

Yudelka was born in the Dominican Republic and attended O&M University in Santo Domingo, where she organized her fellow students against domestic violence and political corruption and served as President of the Unión Democrática de Mujeres, a national organization that organized and educated women. She later obtained a Master's of Science in Urban Policy and Leadership from Hunter College.

Since immigrating to the West Bronx over 30 years ago, Yudelka has made the community her home, raising her four sons there and sending them to New York City public schools. For 23 years, she has worked as a Senior Auditor for the New York City Comptroller's Office.

Yudelka has been deeply involved in her community, serving as PTA President at Roosevelt High School and as an Executive Committee member for the local 1407-DC 37 union. **She has spent years fighting to make her community better for working families like hers.**

Yudelka is a persevering professional, a fighter for our community for more than 30 years, very sensitive to the cause of new immigrant health professionals, and the community in general. We are proud to have this opportunity to recognize her tonight, because we are sure that Yudelka, though her actions will transcend beyond the Bronx District.

Dr. Dante Sánchez

Dr. Dante Sánchez, was an expert professor in mental health. Graduated as a-Doctor in medicine in Autonomous University of Santo Domingo in April 1984. He also did a specialty in -Gyneco-obstetrics and graduated from IDSS and UASD. in 1992. **He was a Professor at UNPHU at New York of School Psychology where he taught Foundations of Psychology, Multicultural Competence and Neuroscience. He was also taught interns on how to master Psychology and prepared Dominicans to practice as professionals in the United States.**

He held a degree in Dialectical Behavioral Therapy from the University of Washington, in 2013, a Certificate in Cognitive Therapy from the Beck Institute in 2011 , a certificate in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, 2009 , a Certificate in Psychiatric Rehabilitation, 2009, Certificate in Multicultural Competence from Prime Institute/Drexel University, 2007. ,Certificate in Recovery/Train the Trainer from Yale Program, 2007, Certificate in Mental Health in Gerontes, Philadelphia Corporation for Aging, 2006. Additionally he completed a one year Postgraduate program in Psychiatry, University of Leon, Lion, Spain. -2006' He had a Drug and Alcohol. Behavioral Health Consulting Certificate from. NJ. in 2000 and was a Certified Hypnotherapist. Graduated from the Well-being Institute. Filadelfia PA, 1999. He worked for the International Visitor Program. United States Information Agency-USIA. Department of State. Washington, USA.

Dr. Dante Sánchez, was a professor in the Clinical master degree Psychology at the Pedro Henriquez Ureña University, co-founder of the Dominican Medical College of the Delaware Valley, with more than 300 members residing in the state of Pennsylvania and New Jersey, Dr. Sanchez was a writer, painter, and folklorist, contributed to the development of Dominican arts and identity in the city of Philadelphia, through well-established institutions such as the Dominican House of Culture of Philadelphia, and the Dominican parade and festival of Philadelphia of which He has been its president.

He was Director of the COMHAR/Latino Treatment Program. Philadelphia, Pa. from 2000-July 15, 2013, where he employed more than 50 Dominicans. **He served over 3,000 Hispanics each year for 13 years.** He helped get work visas for Dominicans. He was also a Consultant-Citywide Comm. Counts. Services in June 2013.He trained Dominicans.-Official Executive Director. Cognitive Behavioral Services Inc. Philadelphia Pa. 2006-Present. It has employed Dominicans and provided services to about three thousand Hispanics every year for 10 years. He also collaborated with a work visa for Dominicans.

Dr. Dante is survived by his wife Deyanira Litka, current CEO of cognitive behavioral services clinic, their four children: Dante Samir, system engineering graduate, Dra. Dafni Sanchez, medical doctor graduate, Deyadira Glanowsky, nurse, Danny Sanchez , bachelor degree in business.

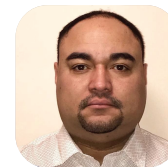

Dr. Senen Caba, Born in Monsenor Nouel, Bonao, Dominican Republic, is the 7th of 9 siblings. He specialized in intensive care at the Hermanos Almeijeras hospital in Havana, Cuba, studied social security at the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina, and also specialized in quality management in health services and modern health management.

In the renowned Dr. Francisco Moscoso Puello teaching hospital, in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he has worked for more than 25 years, and has held numerous positions, some of which include being the coordinator of the internal medicine program, and was the director of teaching at the same hospital. He has also been a professor at 3 different universities. At the Ibero-American University (UNIBE) he was a professor of cardiovascular pathophysiology, at the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo [UASD] he was a postgraduate professor of intensive care for the nursing school, and at the Eugenio María de Hostos University, [UNIREMHOS] he gave classes on medical semiology.



Dr. Cesar valentin

Dr. Cesar Valentin Castillo, was born in the city of Castillo, province of Duarte, Dominican Republic, graduated as a Doctor of Medicine from the Pontificia Catholica University, in Santiago, Dominican Republic.

Dr. César Valentin, has been working in the pediatric clinics "Passaic Pediatrics", as head of the staff, for 15 years, in 3 different offices, located in Passaic, and in the city of Perth Amboy, New Jersey. From this position , Dr.Valentín, has contributed to the vocational development of the new immigrants who have ventured into the health area, offering them guidance, observational internships, to gain experience, and finally offering them jobs. Throughout these 15 years dozens of them have obtained different administrative and academic positions, which have allowed them to work in different institutions. **Dr. Valentin is the owner of "New Jersey supplies" and also of "CVC messenger"**, companies which offers automated services 24 hours a day, processing phone calls, medical appointments, customer service, and channeling emergency calls to medical offices, and this had led to offering dozens of jobs to members of our community. His community work has been recognized by several organizations in the Dominican Republic, and in New jersey. Dr.Valentín is an active member of various professional and community organizations.



Dr. Gustavo Pérez

Dr. Gustavo Pérez, married father of 2 daughters, graduated with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He graduated as a doctor, in medicine, from the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo UASD, Dominican Republic, trained in radiology through the Central University of Venezuela, has a master's degree in clinical counseling through the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo, UASD.

Has a professional license in education from the State of New York, and also holds certification from the State of Pennsylvania in Chemical Dependency National Certification. He has resided in Philadelphia for more than 28 years, working in different mental health clinics, occupying different positions. He is currently the executive director of the Harmony Wellness Group mental health clinic.

He is co-founder of the Dominican medical college, Valley Delaware-Philadelphia branch, the first and only association of Dominican professionals in the state of Pennsylvania, specifically Philadelphia. Additionally, he is the co-founder of the cooperative of Dominican doctors. For 22 years, he has been an advisor to these institutions in several commissions, both in Philadelphia, New York, New Jersey, and the Dominican Republic advocating for services for our immigrant health professionals. Gustavo Perez is currently president of the Dominican Medical Association, Valley Delaware-Philadelphia affiliate, and is also president of the organizing committee for the 20th anniversary celebration of its annual international medical congress of this institution, which represents medical professionals from the state of Pennsylvania, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

His work has been recognized by several institutions both in the United States and also in the Dominican Republic.

Melchor Antonio Martínez

Melchor Antonio Martínez was born in the Dominican Republic in a humble family that was rich in values. From an early age he showed his dedication to service and an extraordinary willingness to help others. This collaborative spirit led him to enroll in the Faculty of Medicine of the Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo, a career from which graduated as a Medical Doctor in 1987. After completing residency, he traveled to the United States to attend a specialized course as a sonographer at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital in New York.

In Philadelphia he was well known for paving the way for Latinos and promoting Latino culture, which led him to becoming co-founder of the first Dominican parade in Philadelphia, the Dominican House, as well as co-founder of the Casa de la Cultura and Dominican Chamber of Commerce in Philadelphia. To his outstanding cultural work he adds an active political and professional life. **Dr. Martínez was a founder of the Dominican Revolutionary Party in Philadelphia (PRD) and was the first president of this organization.** In addition he was the founder and first president of the Philadelphia and Delaware Valley branch of the Dominican Medical College. For his outstanding work on behalf of the Dominican health professionals in the United States, and for opening many doors for employment opportunities for these professionals, Dr. Martínez was awarded the National Prize for Medicine in 1997, making him one of the youngest individuals to receive this distinctive award. To all of these achievements, we add the outstanding work of Dr. Martínez in supporting various social, cultural, professional and commercial Latino organizations. **Without a doubt, Dr. Melchor Martínez has emerged as one of the most influential Latinos of his generation.**
