

Bio: Dr. Aritmedes Restituyo Gomez.

Brief biographical data.

Dr. Aritmedes Restituyo Gomez, a native of Bonao, Monseñor Nouel, is a graduate of the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo UASD, Dominican Republic, as a Doctor of Medicine, has an associate degree in nursing from EDP University, Puerto Rico, graduated with honors from CUM LAUDE, academic coordinator of the national certification program for medical assistant, phlebotomy, EKG, dental assistant, and physical therapy assistant, is an adjunct professor of the Doors to the Future program at Fairleigh Dickinson University, in Hackensack, and Perth Amboy, currently president of the Hispanic Association of Health Professionals Inc NY, also president of the Dominican American Community Association, [DACANJI] in the city of Perth Amboy.

He founded the "Decide to be Healthy" program, or "decide to be healthy" 33 years ago, with which community health fairs are organized in New York, New Jersey, Florida, and Philadelphia.

He has been scientific coordinator of multiple scientific events, among others of the Dominican Medical College, Philadelphia branch, in Reading, Philadelphia, and Virginia, also in Boston, in conjunction with the Dominican Medical College, Boston branch, in New York, he contributed to founding the annual award "Dr. Marcos Charles Santana" which recognizes the work of more than 20 years of services to outstanding professionals in our community, in Barahona, an area in the south of the Dominican Republic, manages to organize the first medical symposium dedicated to the future of tourism and education in that area

Dr. Restituyo, is the founding director of "Better Life Help Corp" Home Health Aide School & Agency, in Perth Amboy, New Jersey, he is also the founding director of TV-AHPSI, your voice!! official means of dissemination of the AHPSI organization, which has been using the zoom platform for more than 2 years, bringing education and prevention in the health area, Hispanic Association of Health Professionals, Inc NY, EL Which arose During the Covid19 pandemic, he has produced more than 150 conferences in various medical specialties.

Dr. Restituyo, in the city of Philadelphia, established the Dominican Medical College, he is also co-founder of the Boston affiliated Dominican Medical College and the Florida affiliated Dominican Medical College.

He is the author of the book `` AHPSI 20 Years, history in photography ".

He is also the author of several articles which offer advice on how to organize a community health fair, tips for obtaining jobs in the health area, and especially advice on how to prepare for the exams to obtain licenses in areas such as medicine, nursing, Dentistry, and Psychology.

Community health fairs organized in schools, parks, churches, in different cities and different states have served more than 175,000 people over these 29 years.

Since 2018, he has been helping to develop the cerebrovascular accident prevention program, throughout the Dominican Republic, together with Dr. Carlos Williams, and the AHPSI board of directors, 2 months ago he began with a pilot plan in 6 hospitals in the city of Santiago, Dominican Republic.

Dr. Restituyo has received dozens of awards for his work with immigrant health professionals, and in the community, from assembly members, mayors, churches, councilors, local agencies, and non-profit organizations.

For more than 33 years, Dr. Aritmedes Restituyo has worked uninterruptedly, advocating for the best insertion of health professionals in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and other states, trying to bring hope to each one of those asking for guidance.
